Modernisation and innovation of ECEC study programmes through introducing a competence based curriculum in Bosnia and Herzegovina

Focus:

The goal of this project is to innovate and modernise the Early Childhood Education and Care undergraduate (first cycle) studies in Bosnia and Herzegovina by introducing a competence based curriculum. The project strives to identify competences the labour market requires, which therefore have to be introduced into the curriculum. Apart from this, the project seeks to improve the interactive teaching methodology and the academic staff's transversal (transferable) skills needed to modernize the study programme as a whole. The project target group consists of the partner institutions' academic staff and students. In a broader context, education institutions and the Early Childhood Education and Care System in Bosnia and Herzegovina will equally benefit from the project.

In accordance with the previously stated, the project attempts to harmonise and modernise the heterogeneous ECEC curriculum and improve the teaching methodology.

DAY ONE 18TH MAY 2017



















Project partners' presentations

Professor Opić from the **University of Zagreb, Croatia** presented the BiH project partners Higher Education Institutions' Early Childhood Education and Care study programmes analysis. The analysis showed equivalence and differences between study programmes which will, at the same time, serve to define the area for harmonisation and modernisation of heterogeneous preschool curricula and improvement of the teaching methodology.


